ASSIGNMENT AND REASSIGNMENT OF CASES

Amended December 1, 2008

(a) All cases shall be assigned by the clerk to a bankruptcy judge as follows:

(i) those cases in which the debtor resides or has its principal place of business in Fairfield or Litchfield Counties shall be assigned to the Bridgeport Division;

(ii) those cases in which the debtor resides or has its principal place of business in Middlesex or New Haven Counties shall be assigned to the New Haven Division; and

(iii) those cases in which the debtor resides or has its principal place of business in Hartford, New London, Tolland or Windham Counties shall be assigned to the Hartford Division.

(b) Upon motion to the judge to whom the case has been assigned and after notice and a hearing, the clerk shall reassign the case to another Division as ordered by that judge upon the findings that such reassignment would be in the best interests of the estate and parties in interest. Upon such reassignment, the clerk shall transmit the case file to the appropriate office of the clerk.
