**ORDER GRANTING
STATE OF CONNECTICUT, DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES'
MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM THE AUTOMATIC STAY**

Upon the Motion for Relief from the Automatic Stay ("Motion") filed by the State of Connecticut, Department of Social Services ("DSS"), moving for relief from the automatic stay, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(1), for cause, to seek before the Superior Court, State of Connecticut, the appointment of a receiver and for such receiver to take possession and operate the Spectrum Healthcare Hartford nursing facility currently operated by the Debtors, and seeking such relief solely to the extent that the "police and regulatory power" exception provided by Bankruptcy Code § 362(b)(4) to the automatic stay does not apply to such actions to be taken by the DSS and the court-appointed receiver; there appearing due and sufficient cause to grant the relief requested, and after notice and a hearing, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Motion is GRANTED; and it is further

ORDERED, that this Court determines that the "police and regulatory power" exception provided by Bankruptcy Code § 362(b)(4) to the automatic stay applies to DSS seeking the appointment by the Superior Court, State of Connecticut, of a receiver and to such receiver taking possession and control over and operating the skilled nursing facilities currently operated by the Debtors, to provide for the health, care and welfare of their residents;

ORDERED, that, notwithstanding the forgoing, relief from the automatic stay be and hereby is granted for "cause" pursuant to Bankruptcy Code § 362(d)(1) to permit DSS to seek the appointment by the Superior Court, State of Connecticut, of a receiver and such receiver to take possession and control over and operate the Spectrum Healthcare Hartford nursing facility currently operated by the Debtors, to provide for the health, care and welfare of their residents; and it is finally

ORDERED, that, in the event the Spectrum Healthcare Hartford facility is placed in receivership, the debtors shall provide such cooperation, assistance and access to resources that are necessary for the receiver to operate the facility and fulfil its responsibilities including but not limited to providing access to books, records and data relating to the Spectrum Healthcare Hartford facility.
