- Free and clear of all liens, claims, and encumbrances, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. 363(f)
- No financing or inspection contingency
- The closing shall occur within 7 days of Bankruptcy Court approval of the sale
- Any party interested in participating in the sale process (each such person, a "Bidder") must submit a bid (a "Qualified Bid") consisting of:
 - A signed Sale Agreement from the Bidder on substantially the same terms as the Buyer in the proposed Sale, except Purchase Price, including any "red line" of any modifications or amendments to the Sale Agreement;
 - A minimum overbid must be at least five (5%) percent more than the Purchase Price in the original Sale Agreement;
 - Must include written evidence that the Trustee reasonably concludes demonstrates that the Bidder has the necessary financial ability to close the sale and provide adequate assurance of future performance; and
 - Must include a written certification, substantially in the form attached to the Sale Agreement, that the Bidder has not engaged and will not engage in any collusion with respect to bidding or the sale.
- All Bids, including any deposit, must be sent to the Trustee so that it is received by the Trustee no later than the Overbid Deadline.

Public Sale/Auction overbid procedure, including bid increments (if any):

- If the Trustee receives one or more timely Bids in addition to the original Buyer's bid, an auction will be conducted (the "Auction") in-person at the Auction Sale Hearing. The opening bid at the Auction will be determined by the Trustee based upon the Bids received. At the Auction, after the opening bid, bidding will be done in increments of at least \$2,000; provided, however, the Trustee and/or Bankruptcy Court shall retain the right to modify the bid increment requirements at any time prior to the close of the Auction. The Trustee will, using her reasonable discretion, identify the highest and best bid (the "Successful Bid") and any second highest bid (the "Back-Up Bid"). The Trustee will ask the Court at the Auction Sale Hearing to approve the Successful Bid and the Back-Up Bid.
- If no Bids are received, the Auction and Auction Sale Hearing will not be held and the Trustee shall be authorized to proceed with closing the sale to the buyer.
