Exhibit A**AUCTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS****2017 12 FLHTCUTG Harley-Davidson Tri Glide**

Date and Time for Bidding: The online-only auction will be conducted at www.bidspotter.com and www.proxibid.com under the category “timed online sales ending.” Bidding on all items will commence at least 14 days before. Bidding will start to close at 1:00 p.m. (Eastern), and each auction lot will be spaced out by one (1) minute. However, to prevent “snipping bids,” Bidspotter and Proxibid employ a dynamic closing: if a bid is placed on a lot or item within the final 2 minutes of the auction, the auction time is extended by an additional 2 minutes to allow more bidding. The auction will end if no bids are placed within the final 2 minutes.

Continuing the Sale: The Trustee reserves the right to continue the sale from time to time and from place to place as she deems appropriate.

Inspections: The bike will be available for inspection, at a minimum, on the day before the scheduled close of the auction sale, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., or by appointment with the Auctioneer. A full catalog and photographs will be prepared in advance of the auction.

Bidding Increments: At the Auction, after the opening bid, bidding on the bike will be conducted in increments as set forth below; provided, however, that the Trustee shall retain the right to modify the bid increment requirements at any time before or during the Auction.

Deposit: No deposit is required; however, Bidders must register with a valid credit card to verify their identity. Unless otherwise ordered or modified by the Court, a \$12,000.00 reserve will be set for the bike.

“AS IS”: The BIKE shall be sold “as is,” “where is,” “how is,” “with all faults,” and with no representations or warranties.

Forms of Payment: Cash, bank check, or wire transfer, payable to the Auctioneer, will be accepted. Phone or online credit card payments will not be accepted to minimize the risk of chargebacks and fees.

Buyer’s Premium: A fifteen (15%) percent buyer’s premium will be charged on all purchases and retained by the Auctioneer, in addition to the Auctioneer's commission from the bankruptcy estate.

Removal: The successful bidder shall be fully responsible for removing all purchased items upon payment in full. No items can be removed from the site without full payment. The bike must be towed from the site unless the successful bidder has a dealer plate or can provide proof of a valid vehicle registration and insurance.

Timing of Removal: All items purchased by successful bidders must be removed within ten (10) calendar days of the auction sale. Removal will be by appointment only with a representative of the Auctioneer onsite. The successful bidder will be responsible for all damages caused by the bidder, its carriers, or its agents.

Authority to Close Backup Bids: If the highest bidder, for any reason, fails to conclude the sale, the Trustee shall be authorized, but not required, to proceed to the next highest bid and close with that bidder.

Subject to Approval: The sale of each of the bike is subject to final approval of the Trustee.

Anti-Collusion Certification: Each bidder will be required to certify in writing, by electronic acknowledgment through acceptance of the auction terms on bidspotter.com and proxibid.com, that it has not engaged, and will not engage, in any collusion with respect to the bidding or the sale.

Modification of Auction Procedures. The Trustee reserves the right, in her reasonable business judgment, in a manner consistent with her fiduciary duties that will best promote the goals of the bidding process, to modify or impose, at or before the Auction, additional customary terms and conditions on the sale of the assets that are reasonably necessary or advisable under the circumstances for conducting the auction sale.

**ORDER RE: MOTION TO SELL BY PUBLIC INTERNET AUCTION
FREE AND CLEAR OF LIENS, CLAIMS, AND ENCUMBRANCES**

Upon the Motion of Bonnie C. Mangan, Trustee in the above-captioned case, seeking to sell assets of the Bankruptcy Estate of Norbert Fonseca, Jr , namely a 2017 12 FLHTCUTG Harley-Davidson Tri Glide, by public internet auction free and clear of all liens, claims, and encumbrances, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 363(f) (the "Motion"), for cause shown, after notice and hearing, and no objections having been filed, it is hereby.

ORDERED that the Motion is GRANTED; and it is further

ORDERED that the Trustee has authority to consummate such sale of the bike² by public internet auction, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 363(b) and (f), with said liens, if any, to attach to the proceeds of the sale to the same extent of the validity, perfection, priority, enforceability, and sufficiency of their lien or security interest in such vehicle; and it is further

ORDERED that the Trustee is authorized to execute and deliver any documents, including but not limited to titles, bills of sale, all forms required by the State of Connecticut Department of Motor Vehicles or other related State or municipal authority, settlement statements, and to perform any acts necessary to conduct and close the sale of the bike; and it is further

ORDERED that the Trustee has the authority to comply with any rules, policies, procedures, or terms and conditions of the internet auction mechanism, bidspotter.com and proxibid.com, disclosed in the Motion and to enter into any agreements in support thereof; and it is further

ORDERED that the Trustee is authorized to pay any fees associated with the use of the internet auction mechanism, bidspotter.com and proxibid.com, without further order of the Bankruptcy Court; and it is further

ORDERED that from the proceeds of the public auction sale, the Trustee is authorized as follows:

- a. First, to pay the usual and customary closing costs associated with the sale of the bike, if any;
- b. Second, upon the filing of an application and further Bankruptcy Court approval, to pay the Auctioneer's statutory commission, costs, and expenses of the public auction sale;
- c. Third, to retain the balance of the proceeds for the Bankruptcy estate, and it is further

ORDERED that, following the conclusion of the public internet auction sale, the Trustee shall file a report of sale as required by Fed. R. Bankr. P. 6004(f)(1) and D. Conn. Bankr. L.R. 6004-3, and it is further

ORDERED that the 14-day stay contained in Fed. R. Bankr. P. 6004(h) is hereby waived, so that the Trustee shall be authorized to begin the sale process for the bike immediately upon entry of this Order.
