



NOTICE OF APPOINTMENT OF CLERK OF COURT

The Judges of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Connecticut are pleased to announce the appointment of Mr. Pietro Cicolini to serve as the Clerk of the Court. Upon the announcement of Ms. Myrna Atwater's retirement after more than 35 years of service to the Court, including serving as the Clerk of Court for more than the last three years, a nationwide search and selection process was conducted. Mr. Cicolini will assume his new position on June 24, 2019.

Mr. Cicolini comes to the Court from his position in the United States Department of Justice as the Court Administrator for the Immigration Court in Hartford and the Acting Court Administrator for the Immigration Court in Boston. Prior to graduating from law school, Mr. Cicolini was a Sergeant in the United States Army Reserve and was deployed to Iraq. In addition to his military service, Mr. Cicolini's prior court experience includes serving as the Courtroom Deputy for the Honorable F. Dennis Saylor, IV, United States District Court Judge for the District of Massachusetts.

Mr. Cicolini's extensive experience managing, supervising, and administering a heavy caseload in the Immigration Courts will serve him well in his new position. The Court is indeed fortunate to have selected a candidate with Mr. Cicolini's deep experience and broad range of skills to assume the leadership of the Clerk's Office.
