NOTICE OF CM/ECF UPGRADE TO NEXTGEN

To CM/ECF FILERS and CM/ECF USERS, Please Be Advised and Take Notice:

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Connecticut ("the Court") will upgrade its CM/ECF system to NextGen on **October 12, 2021.** One of the major features of this upgrade is to allow CM/ECF Filers and Limited Users to use their <u>PACER</u> username and password to e-file with all Courts (appellate, bankruptcy and district) where they have permission to e-file and where the CM/ECF system is upgraded to NextGen. This is a feature known as *Central Sign-On*.

Although our upgrade is not until October 12, 2021, there are 3 steps you can take now to prepare and to ensure a smooth transition to Central Sign-On: **1**.) Know your CM/ECF Username and Password; **2**.) Have a PACER Account; and **3**.) Confirm that your PACER account is "Upgraded".

- KNOW YOUR CM/ECF USERNAME and PASSWORD. Ensure you know your username and password to this Court's <u>CM/ECF</u> system. It is not enough to have your CM/ECF password saved in your browser's memory. <u>You must be able to manually type</u> in your CM/ECF username and password. This will be critically important on October 12, 2021, to successfully link your current Connecticut Bankruptcy CM/ECF login to your PACER login. If you do not know your CM/ECF username or password for this Court, please send a password reset request to: CTB_ECF_HELP@ctb.uscourts.gov.
- 2. HAVE A PACER ACCOUNT. Each CM/ECF Filer and Limiter User must have his/her own PACER account. Shared PACER accounts are no longer allowed once the Court's CM/ECF system has upgraded to NextGen. This applies to creditors with Limited User accounts and all trustees. If you do not have your own PACER account, register for one at: https://pacer.uscourts.gov/register-account/pacer-case-search-only.

- a. Firms may set up a PACER Administrative Account to help manage attorney/limited user accounts and have those individual accounts centrally billed for PACER access fees. View instructions on how to set up a <u>PACER</u> administrative account.
- 3. **CONFIRM THAT YOU HAVE AN <u>UPGRADED</u> PACER ACCOUNT.** In order to link your CM/ECF account to your PACER account, you must have an *Upgraded* PACER account.

To confirm account type and upgrade your PACER account, if necessary, log into your "Manage My Account" in PACER.

- a. Navigate to <u>https://pacer.psc.uscourts.gov/pscof/login.xhtml</u>
 - i. Enter your current <u>PACER</u> (not CM/ECF) Username and Password.
 - 1. If you forgot your current PACER username or password, you may request a reset from the Manage My Account page by selecting *Forgot Your Password?* or *Forgot Username?*.
 - ii. Your Account Type identifies your current PACER Account type.
 - 1. <u>Upgraded PACER Account:</u> No need to upgrade, you will wait until the Court's upgrade to NextGen before linking your CM/ECF account to your PACER account (currently targeted for October 12, 2021).
 - 2. <u>Legacy PACER Account</u>: You must upgrade (click on the link next to your account type that says "Upgrade"). Once upgraded, you will wait until the Court's upgrade to NextGen before linking your CM/ECF account to your PACER account (currently targeted for October 12, 2021).

Once the above steps have been completed, all CM/ECF Filers and Users will wait for further instruction from the Court. Immediately before the go-live date (October 12, 2021), you will receive instruction regarding how to link your CM/ECF credentials to PACER.
