NOTICE TO THE BAR AND THE PUBLIC REGARDING REVISION TO APPENDIX O – LOCAL FORM NOTICE OF SALE OF ESTATE PROPERTY

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that in connection with ongoing review of the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, Appendix O, Local Forms Notice of Sale of Estate Property ("Appendix O Local Forms"), to the Local Rules have been revised. Effective immediately, the new versions of the forms, March 2023, are required to be used. Additionally, the Appendix O Local Forms will be reviewed again as the Local Rules revision process continues this year.

The following four Appendix O Local Forms (Version March 2023) are revised:

- (i) Notice of Proposed Private Sale of Estate Property pursuant to D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(a)
- (ii) Notice of Proposed Public Sale of Estate Property pursuant to D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(a)
- (iii) Notice of Order Granting Motion For Private Sale of Estate Property pursuant to D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(b)
- (iv) Notice of Order Granting Motion for Public Sale of Estate Property pursuant to D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(b)

The Process Pursuant to D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(a). For a sale of property following D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(a), either Local Form Notice of Proposed Private Sale of Estate Property (Local Form CTB-LF238.A1) or Local Form Notice of Proposed Public Sale of Estate Property (Local Form CTB-LF238.A2) must be completed, filed, and served

pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2002(a)(2). Each form for the sale process contemplated in D.

Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(a) must include information supporting the proposed consideration,

the evidence of value of the property, and the efforts undertaken to obtain a higher and better

purchase price. Before filing a Notice of Proposed Private or Public Sale of Estate Property,

information to complete the form must be obtained from the Clerk's Office, including a sale

date, hearing date and time, and, an objection deadline. To request these dates to complete the

form, parties should contact the appropriate Courtroom Deputy using the applicable e-mail

The Process Pursuant to D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(b). For a sale of property

following D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(b), either Local Form Notice of Order Granting

Motion for Private Sale (Local Form CTB-LF238.B1) or Local Form Notice of Order

Granting Motion for Public Sale of Estate Property (Local Form CTB-LF238.B2) must be

completed in accordance with D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(b) and shall be filed only after a

hearing is held and an order enters approving a sale of property free and clear of liens, approving

sale procedures, or entering other appropriate relief related to a sale consistent with D. Conn.

Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(b).

A hearing will be held if an objection is filed or if the Court decides to proceed with a hearing. Note real property must be sold at a public sale unless otherwise ordered by the court. Generally, sales of residential real property using a licensed real estate agent and the Multiple Listing Service will be considered public sales.	Objection date and hearing date to be assigned by the Clerk. Contact Courtroom Deputy for dates by email (see below for email addresses).	This Notice shall be completed and filed in accordance with Fed. R. Bankr. P. 6004(a), (b), and (d), and D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(a), and shall only be completed and filed: (a) For real property, after a Motion is granted authorizing the proposed sale of Real Property by private sale and if conditions in (b) apply; or (b) If a party proposes to sell estate property without filing a Motion to Sell Estate Property, a Motion to Sell Free and Clear of Liens, or a Motion to Approve Sale Procedures, and an Order regarding the Proposed Sale is not required.
