**NOTICE TO THE BAR AND THE PUBLIC
REGARDING GENERAL ORDER 2024-01, RESCISSION OF
INTERIM RULE 1020, AND CHANGES TO OFFICIAL FORMS 101 AND 201**

To the Public and Bar, Please Be Advised and Take Notice:

On July 1, 2024, the Court issued General Order 2024-01, which rescinded Interim Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1020.

Effective June 22, 2024, the Subchapter V and Chapter 13 debt limit provisions of the Bankruptcy Threshold Adjustment and Technical Corrections Act expired when Congress did not act to extend them. As a result, on June 22, 2024, the Chapter 11, Subchapter V debt limit reverted to \$3,024,725, and the two-part Chapter 13 debt limits reverted to (1) \$465,275 for unsecured noncontingent, liquidated debt and (2) less than \$1,395,875 for secured noncontingent, liquidated debt.
