**NOTICE TO THE BAR AND THE PUBLIC
REGARDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE
REVISED LOCAL RULES OF BANKRUPTCY PROCEDURE**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that as described in the PUBLIC NOTICE on January 7, 2026, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Connecticut published revised its Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Local Rules") and began an Open Comment period on January 8, 2026. The Open Comment period ended on February 9, 2026, without comment.

The Local Rules, as revised and published for open comment on January 7, 2026, will be effective as of **March 16, 2026**. All filings made on or after **March 16, 2026**, must comply with the provisions of the revised Local Rules. Additionally, to support compliance with Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1008, which requires that a list be verified or contain an unsworn declaration pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, the Court has adopted a new local form: *Verification of List of Creditors – Local Form CTB-LF-270*.

This Local Form should be used to verify a Creditor List and should be attached to a Creditor List upon filing. The form is available for download on the Court's website under the Local Forms section. Starting **April 6, 2026**, the Clerk's Office will issue a deficiency notice if a List of Creditors is not accompanied by a verification form. Filers are strongly encouraged to begin using the new Local Form Verification of List of Creditors immediately to avoid delays in case processing.
