Instructions for Self-Represented Debtors Paying A Bankruptcy Case (Petition) Filing Fee

What Is the Filing Fee?

When you file a bankruptcy petition under Chapter 7 or 13, a filing fee is required unless an Application to Pay the Filing Fee in Installments or, in a Chapter 7 case, an Application to Have the Chapter 7 Filing Fee Waived, is simultaneously filed with the Petition.

Acceptable Payment Methods

The <u>filing fee</u> can be paid using one of the following methods:

- 1. Online Payment via Pay.gov (Pay.gov Instructions available on the <u>Court's website</u>)
 - Pay by **debit card** or **ACH (electronic bank transfer)**

2. Debit Card

- Accepted in person at the Clerk's Office
- Credit cards are **not** accepted from self-represented individuals for payment of the petition filing fees.

3. Money Order

- Payable to: Clerk, U.S. Bankruptcy Court or Clerk, United States Court
- Must be issued by a recognized provider (e.g., post office, bank)
- 4. Bank Check (Cashier's Check)
 - Payable to: Clerk, U.S. Bankruptcy Court or Clerk, United States Court
- 5. Cash (In Person Only)
 - Must be in the **exact amount.**
 - The Court does not make change.





b How to Submit Your Filing and Payment

Self-represented individuals (also known as a *pro se*) may file a bankruptcy petition **by mail** or **in person** at the Clerk's Office.

If You File a Petition by Mail:

- Do **not** mail cash.
- Pay online via <u>Pay.gov</u>. Instructions and a link to the Pay.gov site for <u>the U.S.</u> <u>Bankruptcy Court for Connecticut</u> is also found on the Court's website: <u>https://www.ctb.uscourts.gov/fees-0</u>
 - You will need to enter a case number in the Pay.gov form. Please enter: 77-77777.
 - You **must include a printed copy** of your Pay.gov **payment receipt** with your petition.

Or

• Enclose the filing fee as a **money order** or **bank check** payable to *Clerk, U.S. Bankruptcy Court or Clerk, United States Court.* Do not mail a personal check, it will be returned. The Court does not accept personal checks for payment of the petition filing fees.

If You File a Petition <u>in Person</u>:

- You may pay by:
 - **Online** via Pay.gov at the time of filing.
 - **Debit Card**
 - Money Order
 - Bank Check
 - **Cash** (exact amount only)
