ORDER EXTENDING AUTOMATIC STAY

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(c)(3)(B), (the "Debtor"), has filed a Motion to Extend the Automatic Stay (the "Motion", ECF No.).

The affidavit of the Debtor attached to the Motion states that the Debtor previously filed a bankruptcy petition within one-year before the petition date of this bankruptcy case, and that previous bankruptcy case filed by the Debtor was dismissed. After notice and a hearing, *see* 11 U.S.C. § 102(1), and in the absence of an Objection to the Motion, the Court finds the affidavit provides clear and convincing evidence that the Debtor filed this case "in good faith as to the creditors to be stayed" within the meaning of 11 U.S.C. § 362(c)(3)(B); it is hereby

ORDERED: The automatic stay of 11 U.S.C. § 362(a) is extended pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(c)(3)(B) and shall continue in full force and effect at all times while this case remains pending before this Court, or until such time the stay is terminated, annulled, modified or conditioned by operation of law or the granting of a Motion for Relief from Stay pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(d) or (e), after notice and a hearing, *see* 11 U.S.C. § 102(1); and it is further
