ORDER AUTHORIZING RULE 2004 EXAMINATION

Upon consideration of the Motion seeking an order authorizing a Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2004 examination of one or more representatives of (the "Motion", ECF No.), filed by (the "Movant"), after notice and a hearing, *see* 11 U.S.C. § 102(1), and in compliance with the Court's Contested Matter Procedure, it appearing that cause exists to grant the requested relief as conditioned hereafter; it is hereby

ORDERED: The Movant may examine one or more representatives of pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2004(a) and within the scope of Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2004(b); and it is further

ORDERED: The attendance of any witness(es) and the production of documents shall be by agreement or compelled in the manner provided in Fed. R. Bankr P. 9016, *see also* Fed R. Bankr. P. 2004(c); and it is further

ORDERED: The examination shall not occur until a date that is at least fourteen (14) days after the service of a Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2004 subpoena, unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties .
