**Public Comment Period for Revised Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure
begins on January 08, 2026, and ends on February 09, 2026**

The Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure for the District of Connecticut were substantially revised in 2018 and then again in 2021. The current version of the Court's Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure has been in effect since August 2, 2021 (the "Local Rules").

Since 2021, the Bench/Bar Local Rules Committee, which is comprised of the three Bankruptcy Judges of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Connecticut (the "Bankruptcy Court") and members of the Commercial Law and Bankruptcy Section of the Connecticut Bar Association, has been reviewing the Local Rules for proposed revisions. In May 2024, the Bench/Bar Local Rules Committee met and solicited input on revisions to the Local Rules from practitioners who appear in the Bankruptcy Court and from members of the Commercial Law and Bankruptcy Section of the Connecticut Bar Association.

A 30-day public comment period for consideration of the proposed revisions to the Local Rules will commence on **January 08, 2026**, and ends on **February 09, 2026**. The "redline" version of the 2026 proposed revisions to the Local Rules is available for review on the Court's website at www.ctb.uscourts.gov. In addition, you may also request a copy of the revisions to the Local Rules by sending an email to LocalRules@ctb.uscourts.gov. This Public Notice will also be posted at the intake counters at each of the three divisional offices of the Clerk's Office.
