<u>Position and Term</u>. Applications are being accepted for the position of term law clerk to the Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge. Two positions may be available. The term of appointment is for at least one year, with an end date to be negotiated. *In-person work in Chambers in New Haven is required. Remote work from home on an occasional basis may be permitted at the option of the Judge.*

<u>General Duties</u>. The Term Law Clerk will report directly to the judge and will collaborate with another Term Law Clerk. Responsibilities include: legal research, preparation of bench memoranda prior to hearings and trials; preparation of draft orders and opinions; maintenance of court calendar deadlines; court attendance during hearings and trials; assistance with law student intern programs; and, other duties as prescribed by the judge. <u>Benefits</u>. This position will be eligible for health and life insurance coverage and participation in the Judiciary's supplemental benefits program.

<u>Qualifications</u>. An eligible candidate must be a law school graduate with a strong academic background, be admitted to and in good standing with any state bar. Applicants must have substantial research and writing experience. The successful candidate will be able to meet strict deadlines within a fast-paced environment and to work both independently and as a team player. Strong writing skills and computer literacy of every kind is assumed and will be essential to success in the position. Prior bankruptcy experience is preferred but not required. Work experience of at least one (1) year after law school or between college and law school is preferred. See posting on https://oscar.uscourts.gov for other important information.

<u>Additional Information for Applicants</u>. Only qualified applicants will be considered or interviewed for this position, and not all applicants will receive a reply. Applicants selected for interviews may be required to provide copies of educational degrees, certifications, references and salary history. Applicants must be U.S. citizens or eligible to work in the United States. As a condition of employment, the candidate selected for this position will be subject to a background investigation and will be fingerprinted.
